The faculty development programme(FDP) was organized for Lecturers/ Teachers of various higher educational institutions of the state of Odisha. The topic of the programme was **“Pedagogy for Effective Teaching”**. The present age is the age of innovation, information & technology. Students from school days are acquainted with internet, computer and other IT & Computer related tools and smart phones. Various schools are adopting different types of IT tools in their teaching pedagogy. When students come to higher education, it is inevitable that teachers must be technology Savvy to provide best teaching to them. With a view to provide wholesome knowledge on different types of innovative teaching tools and techniques as an aid to teaching, the FDP was organized. The programme was a whole day workshop. It was divided into three sessions. Each session was taken by one of the resource person named above. In each of these sessions various innovative means of teaching was taught to teachers. Some of such innovative ways are like use of



case studies, assignments, group presentation by students, teaching as per lesson plan, use of Smart Board, LCD Projector, Video Lectures, Video Clipping on various issues related to the text, Video Conferencing, use of different types of Online Data Base for problem solving, use of Online Portal as virtual platform for teaching real life operational activities etc were taught in the programme. Demonstration was given on each of such methods of teaching so as to make the participants updated and able to use these as tools in their class room teaching.

In the beginning of the session Prof. Parshuram Mishra, Faculty of Finance of the Institute had given a brief presentation on the Draft Guidelines for Human Resource Development Centre (HRDC)-2019. He also briefed about the implementation of some of such guidelines in the institute in the teaching and learning system of the institute. Prof. (Dr.) G.D. Mishra, Director, Srusti Academy of Management has given a brief presentation on the innovative teaching practice of the institute and its effectiveness. Participants from twelve districts of Odisha has participated in the programme. One hundred forty two Teachers from both Junior (Intermediate) and degree colleges consists of various streams like arts, science, commerce, management, engineering etc. had participated in the workshop. Each teachers were provided with Travelling allowance to participate in the programme.
